board should have representation from the Northern-area of the County. Board members requested that resumes for both men be sent out to the board. C. Robinson questioned what "skill set" we are looking for in a new member? J. Zakrevsky advised that, ideally, he would like someone with construction/engineering experience, to replace the skill set we lost with Sarah Harvey. He would also like to encourage females or minorities to join to further diversify the board. He welcomed suggestions for other potential IDA/CRC board members that could be passed on to the County Board.

Starting in 2019, all employees/managers must receive yearly training on sexual harassment prevention in the workplace.
